NCI-SRD Joint Resolution No. 13, series of 2020

APPROVING THE NCI-SRD FY 2021 ANNUAL OPERATIONAL PLANS AND BUDGET

WHEREAS, Chapter 8 of the Philippine Development Plan 2017-2022 states that in order to strengthen the efficiency and effectiveness of strategies, the government will continue to pursue the national convergence initiative using the ridge-to-reef approach;

WHEREAS, Joint Administrative Order (JAO) No. 01, series of 2020 (Revised JAO No. 01 Series of 2015: Strengthening the Implementation Framework for the DA-DAR-DENR-DILG NCI-SRD) identifies the NCI-SRD as a government strategy that can contribute to inclusive growth and poverty reduction in the countryside, through complementation of efforts of the rural development agencies;

WHEREAS, the NCI-SRD Capacity Development (CD), Knowledge Management (KM), Agriculture, Forestry, and Fisheries - Enterprise Cluster and Business Development (AFFECBD) and Policy and Advocacy (PA) Component Working Groups (CWGs) convened in a regular meeting on 10 September 2020, 07 October 2020, 08 October 2020 and 06 November 2020, respectively, and discussed and agreed to endorse their respective FY 2020 Annual Operational Plans and Budget for consolidation of the National Secretariat and subsequent endorsement to the National Technical Working Group (NTWG) for final technical review;

WHEREAS, the NCI-SRD NTWG, composed of the National Focal Person (NFP) and the Chairpersons of the four (4) Component Working Groups (CWGs) convened in a regular meeting held on 10 November 2020, conducted a final technical review of the consolidated NCI-SRD FY 2021 Annual Operational Plans and Budget, and agreed to endorse it to the NCI-SRD National Steering Committee (NSC) for approval;

WHEREAS, the NCI-SRD NSC, composed of the Undersecretaries of DA, DAR, DENR, and DILG, convened in a regular meeting held on 25 November 2020 and approved the NCI-SRD FY 2021 Annual Operational Plans and Budget for submission to the DA-DAR-DENR-DILG Secretaries;

NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, the NSC hereby RESOLVES to approve the NCI-SRD FY 2021 Annual Operational Plans and Budget, implement the indicated programs, activities, and projects, and provide the corresponding funding requirements based on cost-sharing arrangements among the DA-DAR-DENR-DILG, hereto attached as Annex "A".

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FY 2021 Annual Operational Plans and Budget

I. Introduction

For 2021, the NCI-SRD proposes to continue the implementation of the programs, activities and projects (P/A/Ps) stipulated in the following four (4) development plans: (1) NCI-SRD Roadmap for 2018-2030, (2) NCI-SRD Secretariat Strategic Plans for FY 2018-2022, (3) NCI-SRD National Capacity Development Plan for FY 2018-2022, and (4) NCI-SRD Strategic Communications Plan for FY 2021-2025. More specifically, NCI-SRD will focus on the following to support the efforts of government to continuously provide economic opportunities to smallholder farmers, small fisherfolk, IPs, and upland dwellers, in the light of the current COVID-19 crisis:

- 1. Establishment of new convergence areas in the regions;
- 2. Implementation of program, activities and projects (P/A/Ps) in existing convergence areas;
- 3. Harmonization of policies and programs of the DA-DAR-DENR-DILG;
- 4. Advocacy on the proposed National Convergence Strategy Act;
- 5. Development of relevant agriculture, forestry and fishery (AFF) business development modules for the relevant stakeholders in the convergence areas;
- 6. Establishment of guidelines for the implementation of the NCI-SRD Master in Public Management major in Rural Development (MPM-RD) Scholarship Program in FY 2023;
- 7. Development of the revised Convergence Area Development Plans (CADP) Manual of Operations:
- 8. Baseline Study on the Level of Awareness, Knowledge, Participation, and Support on NCI-SRD;
- 9. Establishment of the NCI-SRD Management Information System (MIS); and
- 10. Results-based Monitoring and Evaluation (RBME) of Natividad, Pangasinan Convergence Area.

Annex A provides a consolidation of all activities for the whole year, with corresponding dates, venue, number of participants, budget, funding source, and expected outputs. This takes into account the plans and activities of the National Steering Committee (NSC), National Technical Working Group (NTWG), Component Working Groups (CWGs) and Regional Convergence Initiative TWGs (only for funding that comes from the NCI-SRD).

The following are the seven (7) major expected outputs for FY 2021:

- 1. NCI-SRD relevant policy instruments (at least 10);
- Creation of at least three (3) new convergence areas and/or funding and implementation of 2. CADP of approved convergence areas;
- NCI-SRD MIS; 3.
- Revised CADP Manual of Operations; 4.
- NCI-SRD Business Plan Development and Assessment Module; 5.
- Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) on the MPM-RD Scholarship Program Guidelines; and 6.
- 7. RBME report on the Natividad, Pangasinan Convergence Area.
