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### NCI-SRD RESOLUTION NO. 12 series of 2023

#### AMENDING THE NCI-SRD STRATEGY FRAMEWORK TO INCORPORATE THE AFF SECTOR VISION, MISSION AND GOALS AS STATED IN THE PHILIPPINE DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2023- 2028

**WHEREAS**, the Strategy Framework to Modernize Agriculture and Agribusiness, Chapter 5 of the Philippine Development Plan 2023-2028, states that in order to achieve Outcome 4: Agricultural Institution Strengthened, improved coordination, and convergence of government agencies in planning, programming, and budgeting is needed;

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 15 of the Philippine Development Plan 2023-2028 highlights the list of legislative agenda to accelerate climate action and strengthen disaster resilience including the proposed Integrated Coastal Management (ICM) Act which aims to institutionalize the ICM as a national strategy to ensure the holistic and sustainable management of various ecosystems and natural resources through the “ridge-to-reef” approach;

**WHEREAS**, Joint Administrative Order (JAO) No. 01, series of 2020 (Revised JAO No. 01 Series of 2015: Strengthening the Implementation Framework for the DA-DAR-DENR-DILG NCI-SRD) identifies the NCI-SRD as a government strategy that can contribute to inclusive growth and poverty reduction in the countryside, through complementation of efforts of the rural development agencies;

**WHEREAS**, JAO No. 1, series of 2020 states that the Knowledge Management Component Working Group (KM CWG) shall be responsible for the development and management of an information system for the NCI-SRD which includes Information and Communication Technology (ICT), Results-Based Monitoring and Evaluation (RBME), and Information, Education, Communication, and Motivational (IECM) materials;

**WHEREAS**, the NCI-SRD Strategy Framework, approved under Resolution No. 7, series of 2020, was based on the Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2018-2022 and Ambisyon Natin 2040 identifies the strategy objective, strategic approach, and key result areas of the NCI-SRD;

**WHEREAS**, the PDP 2023-2028 was recently released and identifies new goals, targets, and strategies for the next six years;

**WHEREAS**, members of all Component Working Groups (CWG) during the Initial Drafting Writeshop of the NCI-SRD Roadmap 2023-2028 held on May 2-4, 2023 in Pampanga stated the need to revise the NCI-SRD Framework to update the sector goals as stipulated in the PDP 2023-2028;

**WHEREAS**, the KM CWG during its regular meeting on 15 August 2023 discussed and revised the NCI-SRD Strategy Framework to update the sector goals as stipulated in the PDP 2023-2028;

**WHEREAS**, the NCI-SRD National Technical Working Group (NTWG), composed of the National Focal Person (NFP) and Chairpersons of the four CWG convened in a regular meeting held on 8



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November 2023 and agreed to endorse the amended NCI-SRD Strategy Framework to the National Steering Committee (NSC);


**WHEREAS**, the NCI-SRD NSC, composed of the Secretaries of DA, DAR, DENR, and DILG and represented by their permanent alternate Undersecretaries and representatives, convened in a meeting held on 05 December 2023 and approved the amended NCI-SRD Strategy Framework;


